

Chinese New Year story – make mask props
 Story sequencing: putting events in order
 Small world/ story boxes/felt story boards
 Circle time activities, including: Lola/ Beat Baby/ Philosophy for children questions.

Chinese dragon dance
 Chopsticks & noodles in messy tray/ Cornflour gloop/Dough
 Scissor skills/Dressing & undressing
 Hall sessions – parachute/Sticky Kids/Large & small apparatus (throwing, catching & kicking skills) Balance equipment

Nursery rules & routines/ Rising 3's (3 children start January)
 Role play – 3 Bears House / Chinese restaurant
 Explore & discuss picture cards of story characters – who would they like to be? Encourage descriptive language –happy, brave, kind, strong.
