

- Book spine: Owl Babies.
- The Jolly Postman, Mog and The Vet. Non-fiction books about different professions. Write about **People Who Help Us** visitors.
- Writing sentences with finger spaces and paragraphs about **People Who Help Us**/ booklets about our favourite profession/questions about what we want to know.
- Phonics – phase 3/4 - letter of the week/word of the day/ letter formation/letter recognition and sounds /blending and segmenting, building independent writing.
- High frequency words – starting to spell
- Weekly guided reading
- Story Telling Board – children to use story board to make up their own stories

- Printing an X-Ray by making a printing tile. Print hands in white and paint on bones (tibia and fibula).
- Junk model an emergency vehicle
- Paint pictures of people who help us.
- Experiment with paint and texture – mixing paint and sand/paint and sawdust/paint and rice.
