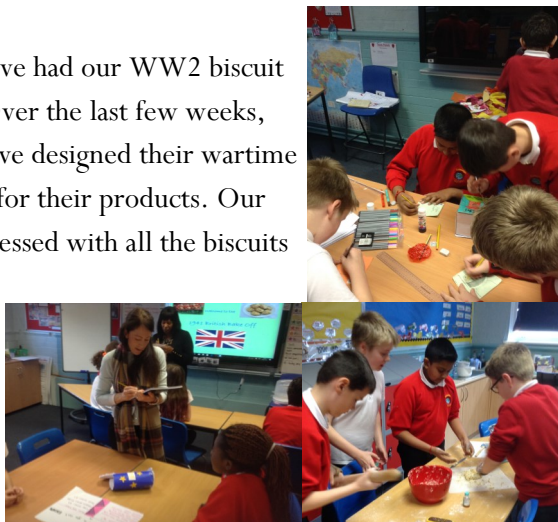
Football
