As the academic year draws to an end, I would like to say a huge well done to all of the children at our school for their inspirational hard work, effort and character. We have well over four hundred children, from the age of three to eleven, and every one of them individually enhances and 'brightens' our school community. On behalf of all the staff; thank you children! It's a privilege and pleasure to have you with us at Cotteridge!

A special mention to all the children in Year 6, who are graduating today and who are more than ready for their move to new schools. I'm delighted to announce that in this year's SATS, 74% of children achieved the age related expectation threshold in all three subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths. The national average was 65% and so for the fourth year running, results at Cotteridge have been significantly higher than other schools in Birmingham and nationally. We were especially delighted to find out that 44% of our pupils achieved the higher 'Greater Depth' standard in the reading test. This is an extraordinary result compared to 28% of pupils across the country achieving the higher standard last year. Whatever their results, every single child in Year 6 has made brilliant progress this year and we're very proud of them all!

Last week the school netball team indeed achieved excellence! For many years Cotteridge has had a very successful team but we have never won the overall Birmingham championships. Last week this changed... The team beat Four Oaks Primary School in the final to be crowned the best primary school netball team in Birmingham. Amazing! A big well done to all the girls, and also to Mrs Smith, who coaches the team with such dedication and passion.

It was a proud moment on Tuesday evening to see boys and girls from across the Juniors, performing at the Symphony Hall. The grand setting is inspirational and it was brilliant to see the energy with which the choir performed. Some of our pupils even had the confidence to compere a section of the show. Well done to all of you!

Thank you to all parents for the support that you have given us over the year. You have wonderful children and our partnership with you is important and appreciated. Thank you! I'm especially grateful to members of the PTA who have volunteered their time to arrange events over the year. You've made a big difference to the school and it doesn't go unnoticed.

The school would not be what it is without the dedication of those who work here. I want to say thank you to all of our staff, who work so hard to give the children a brilliant education. We don't have any staff members leaving us over the summer and I think this reflects the positive team spirit that prevails across the school. It is important that children be taught in happy, joyful schools; and that's exactly what Cotteridge is.
