### School Dinner Bookings And Payments



Please could we remind ALL parents/ carers to book their school lunches every week, even if they are entitled to free school meals, on School Money. Also, if your child brings packed lunches, please could you indicate this. We are finding that some parents/carers are being

charged for dinners when their child brings packed lunches and this is because they are not selecting the packed lunches option on School Money. If all parents/carers book their dinner options for every day, there would be no errors. Also, there are a few parents/carers who are regularly allowing their accounts to run into arrears and are having to be chased for payment. Keeping on top of and chasing late payments is very time consuming for the office staff and it takes them away from the other essential school admin duties. Can we please remind parents/carers that school dinners <u>must be paid at least one</u> <u>week in advance</u> and not in arrears. If you are experiencing any difficulties with logging in to School Money to make payment, please contact the school office who will be able to help. Thank you for your co-operation with this.

# Covid Advice IMPORTANT

If your child or **<u>anyone</u>** in your household has **<u>any one of the</u>** 

### <u>following:</u>

- $\cdot$  a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- · a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

You should arrange for a coronavirus test for the person displaying symptoms and tell the school at your earliest opportunity. **Everyone** in your household must isolate until the person(s) with symptoms have received a negative test result. **This is also the case if you have had a test without experiencing any symptoms.** Please inform the school of your test results as soon as you have received them, whether negative or positive. Even in the event of a negative test result, children should not return to school if they feel unwell. If your child has a fever, they should not return to school until their temperature has been normal for 48 hours.

REMINDER: To report a child's absence due to Covid, please report this via the online form on our school website. There are two forms—one for reporting an absence due to displaying symptoms and awaiting a test/test results and one for reporting an absence due to receiving a positive test result. This new system will enable parents and carers to contact school quickly. This means that you can contact us at any time with this information, including when school is closed. When you submit a form, an alert will go to the senior leadership team who will seek advice and take the recommended actions.
