To round up this week, well done to Year 5 who will be putting on the very first of our year group learning shares today. 5S and 5H have been enjoying their topic on Ancient Greece this term and are thrilled to be able to show their family and visitors their impressive writing and models of their frightening beasts, which inspired their writing. Additionally, the children have designed and made Greek bread for everyone to try and welcome their evaluations as the concluding part of their Design and Technology project. We thank everyone who is coming today to support the children and we hope you enjoy being able to come into school to see what's been going on. The next Learning Share is on Thursday 9th December for Year 1-we look forward to seeing you there!

## **Late Arrivals And Early Leavers**

**IMPORTANT!** Please may we remind Parents/ Carers to attend the office to sign their child in on the screen when arriving late, even if a Teacher intercepts them at the school doors. The office staff have no other way of knowing children have arrived late and if they

have not received their mark on the register, the office staff will presume they are not here unless signed in on the screen. Not only that, in the event of a fire, we use that list to account for any children who were not present to get their marks on the morning



registers. Please could you also use the screen to sign your child out when leaving early, for the same reasons.
