Monitoring Clean Air

You may have seen or heard in national media that schools are receiving CO2 monitors in order to measure the amount of Carbon Dioxide in classrooms. More CO2 will mean that ventilation in the room isn't



as good as it should be in our efforts to minimise the chances of COVID-19 germs hanging around in the air. If the monitors start to show an increase in CO2 then the ventilation in the room will be increased, meaning more fresh, clean air for each classroom.
