The children were absolutely buzzing to have their adults come in and see their learning. We are loving the Learning Shares! They have replaced the class assemblies and really show what quality learning and teaching that is going on within our school, on a day to day basis.

Over the last 2 days, all of the children have taken part in a Walk-a-thon or Sponsored Walk. It has been very blustery but at least it has stayed reasonably dry. The money raised from this sponsored event will go into our School Fund. School Fund is used to advance and enhance the education provided by the school. Income to the fund is obtained from fund raising and voluntary contributions and donations. We also use the fund to collect donations for external charities that are then passed on to the charities. Any money remaining in the fund is kept in the fund for projects that will directly benefit all pupils. The School Fund exists to improve and to enrich the experiences of the pupils at Cotteridge.

Monies raised from the Walk-a-thon can be sent in to school as soon as the children have them. Many thanks in advance for your support with this!

After Easter we will be welcoming a new SENDCo to Cotteridge to build upon the good work Miss O'Brien has done. Her name is Mrs Lucy Hudson and she will be joining us after being a very successful SENDCo at Welsh House Farm. I am sure that you will make Mrs Hudson feel very welcome and I hope that parents of children with specific needs will be able to meet her in person, at some point during the Summer term.
