Ball Skills:

Catching a ball in a game, bounce pass from a short distance to a partner, small sided games 3v3, encouraging chest passes. Scoring in a variety of Ways. Stopping a ball with the sole and inside of feet. Dribble the ball with the inside of feet.

Kwik cricket:

Roll and stop a ball with control/accuracy, throw underarm with some accuracy and catch a ball
Bowl underarm towards a target with control and accuracy, Begin to hold the bat in correct position and hit a ball off a tee, play a modified game.

Space Dance:

Move in time to the music and perform dance movements showing a variety of levels. Perform dance movements showing travelling in different directions e.g. sliding, turning, gesturing Remember simple dance steps, perform with control in time to the music.

Indoor Athletics

Throwing with control using a sitting chest push
Use arms to improve jumping technique. Speed bounce over a cone/mat. Compete in a team in various running races and working in a team.

Habitats: Know how to respect living things in their environment.

Describe the changes that take place in vegetation and animal life in a habitat and a micro-habitat across the four seasons.

Use simple scientific vocabulary to describe their ideas and observations.

Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats.

Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.

Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other

Maths
